Finance Updates

Canteen update

Please note that there is an ongoing delay in getting the system set up for online payments for the canteen, which the catering company, Sodexo, is still working to address. We apologise for the inconvenience.

There were two main reasons why I wanted a cashless system for our canteen. Firstly, it means our students do not need to carry cash around with them. Secondly, from a Covid perspective, it means students do not need to hand cash over to our canteen staff.

In the short term, we are going to grant every student a £2.50 per day overdraft which they can use to pay for food at school from Monday 7th September.

As soon as the online system is set up, the money spent each day by your child will appear as a debit which you will need to pay off before you put any more money on the system to pay for future lunches.

Therefore: from Monday 7th, your child does not need to bring cash to pay for lunch, they can use their overdrafts. Alternatively, they can bring packed lunch.
