

#### Teacher Development and Research

A small number of teachers (Dr Stephens, Miss Roberts and Miss Tolhurst initially) will be using video capture software to record parts of their lessons from Term 2 onwards this year, so that we can analyse teaching across the school and further develop our shared practice as a staff body.

The video software uses an anonymisation filter in black and white (example below), to ensure that no individual in the video is recognisable. We will only ever film from the back of classrooms, and videos are always uploaded to secure, encrypted portal.


