Lateral Flow Testing at Home

Dear parents and carers

We are taking a number of measures to help prevent the spread of Coronavirus, including:

- Encouraging all staff to test regularly, to minimise the risk of our teachers giving your child or other children Covid;
- Ensuring our staff and children practice good hygiene;
- Making sure our spaces are well ventilated and;
- Wearing masks in communal spaces;
- Encouraging all members of our community to isolate and book a <u>PCR test</u> should they develop symptoms of the virus.







We are also asking all parents to <mark>have your children take a lateral flow test on a Sunday and</mark> <mark>Wednesday</mark> and to report each result.

Up to one in three people who have COVID-19 can spread the virus without knowing. This is because they have no symptoms.

Pupils will be able to collect home test kits from school. Please ask your child if they have received these and help them to take the test and report their results. Testing is free of charge.

The tests will come with guidance in multiple languages on how to take the test. You can also see this useful video to show you how to take the test. Tests usually take a few minutes to do and you get the results in 30 minutes. Then all you need to do is to report the result to:

Financial support is available if your child tests positive and you need to self-isolate

If you are unable to work due to your child having, or displaying symptoms of, COVID-19, you may be entitled to a one-off payment of £500 through the <u>NHS Test and Trace Support Payment scheme</u> if you are required to stay at home and self-isolate.

You will be eligible if you live in England and meet all the following criteria:

- you have been asked to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace, including by the NHS COVID-19 app
- you are employed or self-employed
- you cannot work from home and will lose income as a result
- you are claiming at least one of the following benefits:
 - 1. Universal Credit
 - 2. Working Tax Credits
 - 3. income-related Employment and Support Allowance
 - 4. income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
 - 5. Income Support
 - 6. Pension Credit or Housing Benefit

School Absence Due To Illness

Minor ailments should not be a reason for staying at home. If your child attends school when feeling slightly under the weather, but feels worse during the school day, they can let a member of staff know and we will contact you to let you know if we think your child needs to go home.

If your child is too ill to attend school, you must notify the academy before 9:00am on the first day of absence. If your child is ill for more than one day, you will need to notify the academy on each morning of the absence, unless otherwise agreed.

To report an absence, please contact John Cabot Academy on 0117 9763000 and select option 2 to leave a message on the attendance line.

Please clearly explain the symptoms your child has, when the symptoms started, and when you expect them to be well enough to return to school.

By law, schools must record all pupil absences and whether the absence is authorised or unauthorised.

SCOPAY - Online Payment System - Preferred Method of Payment

SCOPAY is our preferred method of payment for all transactions when making payments to the academy. This system allows you to make payments for trips, events, music tuition and learning resources plus your child's school lunch account can also be topped up using this system. The system can be used on a desktop computer, or you can download the App to use on your mobile phone or tablet meaning that you can access your account at any time.

Purchase of School Uniform

Purchases of School Ties

The option to purchase a school tie for £6.00 via SCOPAY is available for every student and SCOPAY continues to be our preferred method of payment. If your child has lost their tie, you can purchase a replacement via your SCOPAY account, and it will be available for collection by your child the following school day.

Alternatively, for ties only, a cash payment can be accepted at the Finance Office – please send your child with the correct cash payment of ± 6.00 in an envelope with their full name, year group and tutor group detailed.

Please ask your child to collect their tie from the Finance Office. The Finance Office is open to students every day before school and during break time.

Purchases of Calculators

The option to purchase a calculator from the academy is available to all students via SCOPAY.

If you wish to purchase a calculator for your child, there are two types available and currently in stock:







- Casio ClassWiz FX991EX Scientific Calculator @ £19.50 each, or
- Casio FX-83GTX Scientific Calculator @ £8.50 each

Your child's Maths Teacher will be able to advise on which calculator is appropriate for them.

Purchase of Memory Cards for GCSE Photography
