Since 2015 almost 38,000 pupils have participated in the Health and Wellbeing Survey. It gives school really detailed information on the Health and Wellbeing of our students and crucially what we can do to support them.

The survey is open to all JCA students until <u>Friday 31st March 2023</u>. We are asking that you support your young person in completing this survey online via the link shared on <u>Show My Homework</u>. Login details are in the SMHW link. Please note: the characters in the password are all lower case and are case sensitive. Please check the caps lock is off. Students can copy and paste into the server.

The survey is designed to be completed on PCs, laptops, and tablets – the survey does not function well on smartphones.

The survey is completely anonymous and retains no personal data.
