JCA Routines – Uniform and Punctuality to School

As the temperature rises, even on cloudy days, our JCA building can get very warm. In a couple of weeks, after the May half term, students will no longer be able to wear outer layers when inside the school building. Compulsory Items

Tie * JCA clip-on tie. Trousers Formal black trousers with a crease. (Jeans/other fashion styles are not permitted.) Shirt White, long or short sleeve, buttoning to the neck. To be worn with a tie. Skirt * Blue, tartan skirt. Can be worn instead of trousers. Only available through Trutex. Tights Black, grey or neutral. Socks White, black, dark blue or grey. School Shoes Black, substantial (No trainers, daps or boots). Items marked * are only available through our uniform supplier, Trutex. Other items can be purchased elsewhere as long as they meet school expectations.

Poetry Competition


