#### Road Safety

Please be aware of roadworks for example at the end of the road, the layout has changed and can cause confusion, and people are unsure of the right of way.

If you ride a bike or a scooter, ensure you wear a helmet, please make sure the helmet fits properly. Look right, look left, look right again.

#### Walking Home

Always use pavements and footpaths, rather than being in the road, crossing safely if need to get onto a path at the other side - look left, look right, look again.

Where possible always good to walk with friends and peers or if walking on your own using busier streets, paths for instance past shops, houses.

Be aware of your surroundings and refrain from using headphones, restrict looking at your phone as you will not be paying attention to things going on around you.

Ensure if you are due home after school you let home know if you are not going straight there.

As always, if your child is ever worried about anything on the way home from school, they should always come back to the school building, staff will help.

Please do remember that our neighbours (both in person and on their property) deserve the same kindness and respect with which we treat all members of the JCA community; please ensure your child is aware of how to keep others safe.


