JCA Routines – Corridors and Social Time Behaviours

In our classrooms, we use consistent boundaries and well understood routines called 'Ready to Learn'; students know and follow this routine well. As students move into corridors to transition between lessons and / or during their social times, some of these behaviours where we empower each other to feel safe are not followed. Recent student voice has told us that some students find moving between lessons an unpredictable time; noise levels rise and other students show less care towards each other.

Over the next few weeks, staff will be trialling clearer language with students to ensure we, as a community, value our behaviour in the same way we do in our classrooms.
