
Green Jobs are Growing!

You may be aware that the West of England Combined Authority aims to make the region net zero by 2030, 20 years ahead of the UK Government's target. This may require up to 45,000 new green jobs across six priority areas: Nature Recovery, Low Carbon Buildings and Places, Renewable Energy, Climate Resilience, Low Carbon Business and Low Carbon Transport, providing some exciting employment opportunities for young people in the West of England area.
